The program is organized by age and gender, and carried out through "Tribes" consisting of approximately 5-10 parent/child pairs, which meet 1-2 times per month. Tribe meetings are held at either a member's home, a YMCA room, or another designated place. Parents and children participate in crafts, tell stories, play games and have an evening of fun together. Once a month all tribes in the Chumash Nation come together for a Nation Event, which can include campouts, beach trips, hiking, a pinewood derby, and much more!

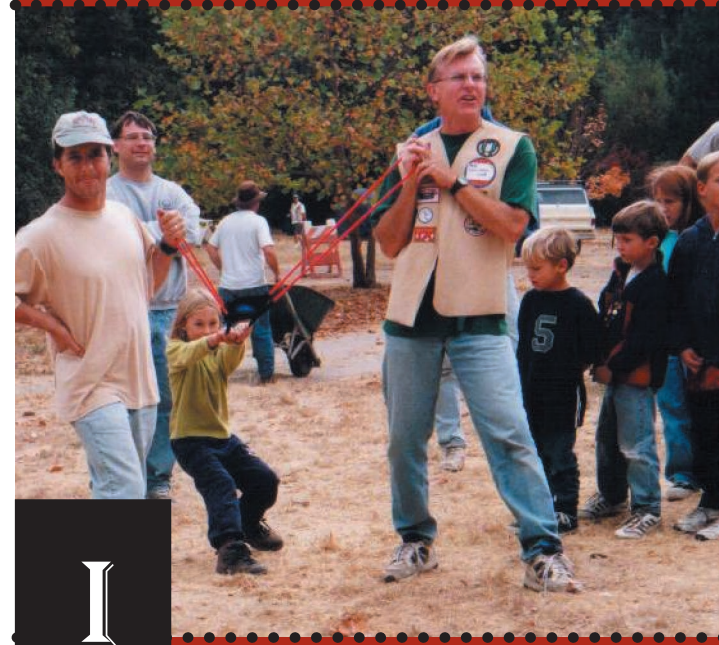
